



The Presentation of the 2011 Aquatic Facility of the Year Award

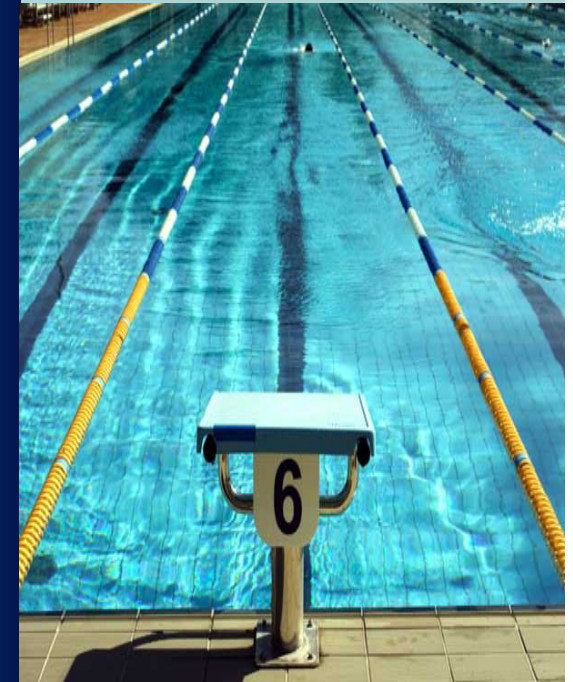

Two categories;

- A. All Year Aquatic Facility
- B. Outdoor Aquatic Facility

This includes improved financial viability, human resource practices, infrastructure development, risk management and strategic planning.

Applications will be judged on the facilities performance in 6 key areas.

Please ensure applications are restricted to less than 20 pages.

Judging Criteria

- Infrastructure
- Environmental Efficiency
- Financial Viability
- Innovative Programming
- HR
- Risk Management

NOTE: The award is about effectively using your facility, NOT having the newest facility.

Applications should cover the following areas

Infrastructure

- Innovative use of the infrastructure

Environmental Efficiency

- Efficient/ innovative water reduction measures
- Energy efficiency
- Recycling waste/ minimisation

Compliance with SA Health Dept Legislation and standards.

Financial Viability

- Innovative ways to increase financial viability
- Secondary income, i.e. cafe, swim school etc

Innovative Programming

- Diversity
- Culturally and Linguistically Diverse programs
- Child Safety Programs

HR

- Innovative staffing (retention)
- Minimise staff turnover
- Career Development Opportunities
- Coping with staff shortages in hot weather

Risk Management Approaches

- Action/management processes in response
- Innovative responses
